## After School Reading Program

Help your child build the reading skills they need to succeed today!

## How to get started:



1. Check with your child's school for eligibility
2. Complete the SES form and list **August House** as your SES provider
3. Return the form to the school office
4. Find a computer your child can use with high speed internet access

August House will show your child the path to reading success!

## **What is the cost?**

There are no fees or costs to you beyond the expense of internet access. If your child is eligible, the Department of Education and your child's school offer our program at no charge to you.

## **Does my child qualify for reading tutoring?**

Your child may receive free tutoring services, if he or she receives free or reduced lunch at school and attends a Title I school that has been on the "Needs Improvement" list for 3 years.

## **Where will the tutoring take place?**

Students can use the program anywhere they can use a computer connected to the internet with high speed access. You may find access at school, your local library, or nearby community center.

## **Who will supervise my child?**

Since our reading program is delivered online with a computer, it is up to you to monitor your child.

## **How does it work?**

Our reading program is based on the core reading skills defined by the State of Georgia. Each child begins the program by taking a grade level test to help identify specific strengths and weaknesses. Based on this test, the program will provide assignments to practice the skills each child needs to become a better reader.

Students will see an animated version of the story to get started. Then they will use the book and the computer to complete their practice work.
